#### 10.15–11.15 am Tourism Tasmania, CEO John Fitzgerald

T21 is the partnership between the Tasmanian Government and the tourism industry that sets the strategic direction for the visitor economy across the State. In late 2019 around 500 industry and visitor economy stakeholders met in 18 workshops around the state to discuss the ten-year vision for tourism in Tasmania, informing the 2030 Visitor Economy Strategy. The workshops identified a common vision for a future where our industry is more deliberate in our agenda for responsible and sustainable tourism. Since the COVID pandemic, tourism and hospitality have been hit hard by the measures required to contain coronavirus. The ten-year strategy has now shifted with work focussing on a two-year recovery plan, due for release in August 2020. This will be followed by a longer term plan in later 2022. Anne will discuss the priorities of the recovery plan and the longer-term aspirations for tourism.
