### **Terms of use for secure access**

You agree to the following terms of use in relation to your access and use of this Extranet on your own behalf and on behalf of your organisation / employer. You confirm that you are an authorised representative of your organisation/employer and are entitled to agree to these terms of use on behalf of your organisation / employer. You agree to ensure that all employees and officers of your organisation / employer who have access to this Extranet are aware of and will be bound by these terms of use.
